**ONTARIO COUNTY REQUESTS CONTINUED PUBLIC INPUT ON DRAFTING OF LOCAL
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE**

August 15, 2025, Canandaigua, NY: Ontario County is updating their Local Solid Waste Management Plan (LSWMP). The new LSWMP will provide a countywide framework for the coordination of solid waste management in an environmentally safe and economically sustainable manner for the next ten years. The LSWMP will establish solid waste management goals and objectives, including an overall waste reduction goal and a plan to monitor progress in alignment with state requirements.

The County has created and launched a website to engage the public and get residential input in June. Interested residents can visit the following link <https://bandl.mysocialpinpoint.com/ontario-county-lswmp> to complete a residential survey, answer polling questions, or provide general comments. The link is also available via the [OntarioCountyRecycles.org](https://ontariocountyrecycles.org) landing page. The survey will be available through September 14th. The County is thankful to the 300+ participants that have already provided feedback. Your input is very important to shaping the LSWMP goals and objectives.

“The development of a comprehensive LSWMP will provide Ontario County with policy and program direction for the next decade,” said Carla Jordan, Director of the Ontario County Department of Sustainability and Solid Waste Management. Jordan continued, “We recognize that residents, business owners, local municipalities, and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation all play an important role in the current and future management of solid waste and recycling. We are continuing to seek public engagement in this process and look forward to thoughtful engagement through the online information hub.”

This is just one piece of the ongoing waste diversion efforts in Ontario County. The Department of Sustainability & Solid Waste Management provides information and resources to support residents, businesses, and municipalities in their recycling and waste reduction efforts throughout the year.
