**ONTARIO COUNTY ANNOUNCES RELEASE OF DRAFT LOCAL SOLID WASTE  
MANAGEMENT PLAN AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

**October 27, 2025, Canandaigua, NY:** Ontario County is updating their Local Solid Waste Management Plan (LSWMP). The new LSWMP will provide a countywide framework for the coordination of solid waste management in an environmentally safe and economically sustainable manner for the next ten years. The LSWMP will establish solid waste management goals and objectives, including an overall waste reduction goal and a plan to monitor progress in alignment with state requirements.

The Ontario County Board of Supervisors has released the draft Local Solid Waste Management Plan and the forty-five (45) day public comment period is now open, and will close on December 7, 2025. “Ontario County is thankful for the residential input that we received on the front end of the plan’s drafting, and look forward to continued public participation through the public comment period,” said Carla Jordan, Director of the Ontario County Department of Sustainability and Solid Waste Management. “In alignment with residential input, stakeholder feedback, and state policy, the County aims to build a more resilient and sustainable solid waste management system for the decade ahead.”
